



## Sherry Hall

December 24, 1950 - April 5, 2026

Sherry (Robinson) Hall, age 75 years, a resident of rural Eddyville, Illinois, passed away Sunday afternoon, April 5, 2026, at the University of Louisville Hospital in Louisville, Kentucky.

Sherry was born December 24, 1950 in the Robbs community in Pope County Illinois. She was the daughter of Clyde M. and Susie J. (White) Robinson.

On February 24, 1971, Sherry was united in marriage to James W. Hall at the Glendale United Methodist Church. He survives.
