Sue Stubblefield, age 83 years, a resident of the Hillerman community, passed away Thursday afternoon, May 9, 2019, at 12:15 PM at the Metropolis Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Sue was born May 31, 1935 in Karnak, Illinois. She was the second of five children born to Roland Deward and Helen Mae (Bunker) Astin.

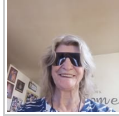
