Tennie E. Hutchison, daughter of Will Jaco & Emma (Helm) Jaco, was born August 10, 1917 in Reevesville, IL. She departed this life Tuesday morning, February 3, 2004 at 6:45 AM, at Western Baptist Hospital in Paducah, KY. At the time of her passing, Tennie had attained the age of 86 years 5 months & 24 days.

Tennie was united in marriage to Joseph Ward Hutchison on April 17, 1937 at the Powers Church in Massac County Illinois by Rev. W.L. "Buck" Cummins. Ward preceded her in death on December 13, 1990.
