Thelma Lucille Marks, age 87 years, a former resident of Buncombe, passed away Thursday evening, October 24, 2019, at 9 PM at the Hillview Health Care Center in Vienna.

Lucille was born January 17, 1932 in Johnson County Illinois. She was the daughter of Frantie and Della (Walker) Howard.

On September 9, 1946, Lucille was united in marriage to Gene Marks in Williamson County Illinois. He preceded her in death on May 12, 2000.
