



Timothy Ray Quigley

August 19, 1963 - January 5, 2025

Timothy Ray Quigley, age 61 years, a resident of Goreville and a former resident of Vienna, passed away Sunday morning, January 5, 2025, at the Marion V.A. Community Living Center.

Tim was born August 19, 1963 in Hollywood, California.

Survivors include: his children – Kaela (Josh) Bradley of Golconda, Illinois; Ariel Quigley of Carbondale, Illinois, and Chase Quigley of Goreville, Illinois; grandchildren – Boston Bradley and Bronx Bradley; and a sister – Joyce Rushing of Paoli, Indiana.

Tim was preceded in death by: his father – Robert Anthony Quigley; his mother – Norma (Clardy) Clark; and 4 sisters – Brenda Smith, Patty Peppers, Diana Quigley and Roberta Quigley.

Tim was a graduate of Pope County Community High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Army and served honorably for 27 years. Tim retired with the rank of First Sergeant.

Following his retirement from military service, Tim began working for the Illinois Department of Corrections. He was employed at the Dixon Springs Impact Incarceration Program (IIP). Later he worked at the Vienna

Correctional Center and finally at the Shawnee Correctional Center, prior to his retirement in 2015.

More recently, Tim was employed by American Monument Co. as a memorial installer and engraver.

Tim was a member of Williamson Lodge # 802 A.F. & A.M. at Hurst.

He enjoyed watching sports events and motorcycling.

Tim was of the Christian faith.

A service honoring the life of Timothy Ray Quigley will be conducted Sunday afternoon, January 12, 2025, at 1:30 P.M. at Bailey Funeral Home in Vienna. Dr. Glenn Webb will officiate.

Burial, with military honors, will be in the Cedar Grove Cemetery in Pope County Illinois.

Visitation will be held Saturday evening, January 11, 2025, from 5 P.M. until 7 P.M. at the funeral home.

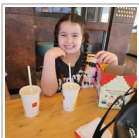
