Virginia L. Breeden Jones, age 83 years, a former resident of Metropolis, Illinois, passed away Monday morning, June 14, 2021, at 10:14 AM at River Crossing of East Peoria.

Virginia was born October 24, 1937 near Morley, Missouri. She was the daughter of Arlen and Louise (Cruse) Campbell.

Virginia was united in marriage to Glenn Breeden on June 26, 1955. To this union three children were born: Steve Breeden, Jan Hirst, and Gina Haylow. Glenn preceded her in death on November 10, 1996.
