William "Bill" Larrison, age 81, a resident of rural Belknap, passed away Monday August 4, 2014, at 12:25 PM at his home.

Bill was born October 7, 1932 in the Wetaug community. He was the son of Tom and Helen (Doane) Larrison.

On April 7, 1982, Bill was united in marriage to Alice M. (Eastwood) at Belknap. She survives.
